

**4-H is Department J (11) and FFA is Department I (21)**

**4-H AND FFA DAIRY CATTLE REGULATIONS**

1. All animals must have been owned or leased by the exhibitor prior to June 1 and registered with the respective breed association in the exhibitor's name.
2. Each exhibitor will be limited to two entries in each individual class.
3. Senior yearling heifers in milk must show in a 2-year-old freshened class.
4. All exhibitors must be neatly and properly dressed (preferably in white) while in the show ring.
5. 4-H Food Quality Assurance Policy for 2017  
By June 1, 2017, all 4-H members enrolled in food animal projects including beef, sheep, swine, dairy cattle, meat and dairy goats, rabbits and poultry must complete the appropriate level of Missouri Show Me Quality Assurance certification to be considered a 4-H member in good standing in that project. No further quality assurance documentation is needed with the State Fair entry.

NOTE: 4-H members must be in good standing in their county to enter the State Fair food animal related competitions. (Reference rule 1, C)

**DAIRY CATTLE CLASSES**

Exhibitors must refer to the Open Show and use those class numbers for 4-H, FFA and Open, with the exception that there are no group classes in 4-H/FFA.
