

4-H is Department J (14) and FFA is Department I (24)**4-H AND FFA DAIRY GOAT REGULATIONS**

1. All animals must be inspected by the state veterinary prior to unloading. After inspection, check with superintendent for penning assignments.
2. The base date for computing the ages of goats in all classes will be August 19th.
3. All animals shown must have been owned by the exhibitor since June 1 or before of the current year. Proof of ownership, registration, and tattoo requirements will be the same as for the open show.
4. Exhibitors are limited to two monies per individual class and 1 money per group class.
5. Every goat must be properly fitted for show and be provided with a collar. All exhibitors must be neatly and properly dressed (preferably in white) while in the show ring.
6. All goats in the show are subject to the same feed and health regulations as shown in the open goat regulations and the general regulations in this on-line premium guide.
7. A showmanship contest will be held as part of the Dairy Goat Show. Age Groups: 8-10 Juniors; 11-13 Intermediate; 14-16 Senior; 17-21 Experienced Senior.
8. 4-H Food Quality Assurance Policy for 2017
By June 1, 2017, all 4-H members enrolled in food animal projects including beef, sheep, swine, dairy cattle, meat and dairy goats, rabbits and poultry must complete the appropriate level of Missouri Show Me Quality Assurance certification to be considered a 4-H member in good standing in that project. No further quality assurance documentation is needed with the State Fair entry.
NOTE: 4-H members must be in good standing in their county to enter the State Fair food animal related competitions. (Reference rule 1, C)

DAIRY GOAT SHOWMANSHIP

A showmanship contest will be held as part of the Dairy Goat Show. 4-H Age Groups: 8-10 Juniors; 11-13 Intermediate; 14-16 Senior; 17-21 Experienced Senior. FFA will have a Senior and Experienced Senior Classes. When competing in Showmanship, exhibitors must choose either 4H or FFA.

DAIRY GOAT CLASSES

Class numbers will be the same, except a letter will be added to a class to designate the breed as follows: A) Alpine; B) LaMancha; C) Nigerian Dwarf; D) Nubian; E) Saanen; F) Sable; G) Toggenburg; I) Oberhasli; H) Recorded Grade and K) Kinder.

Classes in the breed show and open show should match, with the exception that there are no group classes in 4-H/FFA.

4-H/FFA shows will follow the open show order.
