MISSOURI STATE FAIR FOUNDATION YOUTH IN AG SCHOLARSHIP

The Missouri State Fair Foundation Youth in Agriculture Committee administers the scholarships financially and an appointed committee is responsible for the selection of the winners. In 2016-2017, thirty scholarships were offered in the amount of \$1,500 each, and one Platinum scholarship was awarded for \$5,000 and one Supreme Scholarship was awarded for \$2,500. Prerequisites for scholarships are as follows:

1. Be a high school senior.
2. Be an active 4-H or FFA member.
3. Have participated in the Missouri State Fair as an exhibitor of 4-H or FFA.
4. Plan to enroll in an accredited Missouri college or university. Scholarship applicants planning to pursue an Agriculture degree will be given five bonus points during the selection process.
5. Scholarship recipients must enroll (fall and/or spring semester immediately following graduation from high school) at an accredited community college, college or university in the state of Missouri. To receive scholarship funds awarded, recipients must submit proof of enrollment prior to February 1.
