- 4. Selected students must enroll (fall and/or spring semester immediately following graduation from high school) in an accredited community college, college or university.
- 5. If a selected student declines a scholarship, the Youth in Agriculture Committee should be notified by October 1, 2024 at which time all recipients (including alternates) will move up in rank.
- 6. Applicants must have a high school counselor complete the section and sign for their ACT/ SAT score and GPA.
- 7. Please do not include unrequested documents (i.e. resume, school transcript, etc.)
- 8. To receive the scholarship funds awarded, recipients must submit proof of enrollment prior to January 16, 2025.
