In addition to celebrating the big win, they are also celebrating their 170th anniversary this year. The winery is the oldest continually family-owned winery in the country dating back to 1855. The 7th generation of Puchtas runs the business these days.

Adding to its unique charm, this collection comes in a commemorative wooden crate made by former State Fair Director Mark Wolfe. Don't miss your chance to own a shining example Missouri's winemaking expertise. Bid high and take home not just a case of wine, but a story worth cherishing. The Governor has autographed one of the bottles as a keepsake.
