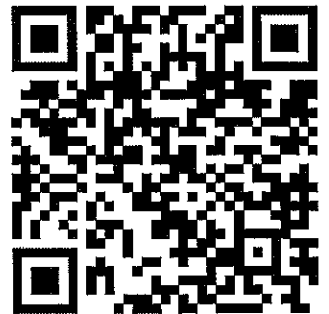

Missouri Governor's Cup Wine

These 12 bottles were recently awarded the highest honor a wine can receive in the state – The 2026 Missouri Governor's Cup Award for best wine in the Show-Me State. The pinnacle of the competition was awarded to Adam Puchta Winery for their 2025 Dry Vignoles wine. A panel of esteemed wine experts from around the country blindly evaluated nearly 300 wines before landing on this as their final selection. The winery is the oldest continually family-owned winery in the country dating back to 1855. The 7th generation of Puchtas now runs the business.

– Adding to its unique charm, this collection comes in a commemorative wooden crate made by former State Fair Director Mark Wolfe. Don't miss your chance to own a shining example Missouri's winemaking expertise. Bid high and take home not just a case of wine, but a story worth cherishing. The Governor has autographed one of the bottles as a keepsake.
