length of time to be determined by the Missouri State Fair Com-
mission or the Director of the Missouri State Fair on behalf of the
Commission. Suspensions can be for any length of time and may
be permanent.
- C. Probationary exhibiting at the Missouri State Fair for a length of
time and under such terms and conditions to be determined by the
Missouri State Fair Commission or the Director of the Missouri
State Fair on behalf of the Commission.
- D. Assessment of any other penalty determined by the Missouri State
Fair Commission or the Director of the Missouri State Fair on
behalf of the Commission.

OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All exhibitors must be eighteen years of age or older and a resident
of Missouri. An entry fee of \$2.50 per piece, limit two (2) pieces.
Make checks or money orders payable to Missouri State Fair. DO
NOT SEND CASH. Entries must be received by July 21.
2. The Missouri State Fair does not guarantee premium money, mer-
chandise, prizes or special awards. Because the State Fair Commis-
sion is without constitutional or statutory authority to borrow money
for its operation, it reserves the right to prorate premium money
because of state budget restraints.
3. Work must be original work by the artist entering and not previously
shown at the Missouri State Fair and completed within the last three
(3) years.
4. Art work will be accepted Saturday, July 26, Saturday, August 2 from
10 a.m. to 2 p.m. and Sunday, August 3 from 2 to 5 p.m. in the Fine
Arts Building. If you cannot deliver your work at the designated
times, please make arrangements to have someone else deliver
your work for you. Artwork will not be accepted before July 26. Last
day to deliver artwork is August 3, 5 p.m. NO EXCEPTIONS. If ship-
ping, ship prepaid to arrive by July 26, to the Fine Arts Department,
Missouri State Fair, 2503 W. 16th St., Sedalia, MO 65301. If return
shipment is requested, a \$25 handling fee is due upon receipt of
the work and prepaid return postage. Make checks or money orders
payable to the Missouri State Fair. DO NOT SEND CASH.
5. Exhibitors may submit two (2) entries. **Photograph may be any size
up to 11" x 14" and must be permanently mounted on 11" x 14"
stiff board, sometimes call foam core. No Poster Board. Overall
finished size must be 11" x 14".** Double matting or window matting
is permitted. Overall thickness not to exceed 1/4". Artwork in the
Photography Division is displayed on narrow shelves, side by side,
and the 11" x 14" overall size requirement allows room for many
entries and gives an overall neat and consistent look to the exhibit.
Please follow the guidelines and be sure the outside dimensions of
your artwork are 11" x 14", even if the photograph is much smaller
than 11" x 14". Photographs may be shrink wrapped or covered with
acetate. No frames or hanging materials are permitted. Work not
meeting these requirements will not be shown.
6. The artist's signature verifies the understanding that all work submit-
ted is at the artist's own risk. The Missouri State Fair cannot assume
responsibility for lost or damaged art work. Any insurance coverage
must be provided by the artist.
7. The primary audience of the Missouri State Fair consists of families
and youth. The Missouri State Fair reserves the right to reject any
works of art that may be considered objectionable by that audience.
8. Exhibitor tags will be available at check in. Exhibitor tags will NOT be
mailed to the exhibitor.
9. Art work may be picked up Sunday, August 17, 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. or
Monday, August 18, between 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. at the Fine
Arts Building. Last time to pick up artwork at the Fine Arts Build-
ing will be 12 p.m. Monday, August 18. If you cannot pickup your
work at the designated times, please make arrangements to have
someone else pick up your work for you. Work that is not picked up
Sunday or Monday will be available for pick up at the Administrative
Offices on Tuesday, August 19, from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and
1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Any work not picked up within 10 days after
the Fair closes will become the property of the Missouri State Fair
unless prior arrangements have been made.
10. Work that is for sale will be charged a 25% commission if sold during
the Fair. Please price your piece accordingly.
